

BILL DELANEY BASKETBALL PROGRAM

The goals of the Bill DeLaney Basketball Program are to provide quality basketball competition, skill development and the promotion of good sportsmanship. To have a successful program, there must be understanding and cooperation among parents, players and coaches. Our player's progress will depend, to a great extent, on this triangular relationship. This is a crucial factor in the success of the program.

Please understand that all coaches, players and parents are representatives of the Bill DeLaney Basketball Program. Everyone will conduct themselves in such a manner as to not bring discredit to themselves, the team or the program.

PLAYERS CODE OF CONDUCT

1. Players are expected to demonstrate commitment to the team, teammates, and coaches.
2. Players will be courteous to visiting teams and officials.
3. Players are expected to play hard and to the best of their abilities. The True Athlete does not give up, quarrel, cheat or grandstand.
4. Players are expected to cooperate with their teammates and coaches.
5. Players will obey the rules of the game.
6. Players will be modest when successful and be gracious in defeat. A True Sportsman does not offer excuses for failure.
7. Players will refrain from profanity in games and practices.
8. Players will not participate in physical violence or threats thereof during any games or practices, under any circumstances. Players will control their tempers and resist the temptation to retaliate.
9. Players will not argue with or complain about referees, teammates, coaches, opponents and spectators. The players will report problems or complaints regarding the game or practice to the coach.
10. Players will respect the integrity and judgment of officials and accept their decisions **Without Question!**
11. Should a player receive an In School Suspension, the player will not be allowed to practice for one week and will not be allowed to play in the next scheduled game. Should a player receive an Out of School Suspension, the player will not be allowed to practice for one week and not allowed to play in the next two scheduled games. Any second violation will result in the player being suspended from the program for the remainder of the season and playoffs.

** Should a player violate any of rules 1 through 10, the player with his parents and coach will meet to resolve the issue at hand. At the conclusion of the practice or game, the coach will discuss, with the player and their parents, his /her actions. If the issue is unresolved, then the Board is contacted. Be advised, the Board will review the issue and may impose one of the following disciplinary actions -verbal warning, a practice or game suspension, expulsion.
